

“The Big Bang?”



The “Big Bang” theory is an effort to explain what happened at the very beginning of our universe.

“Discoveries in astronomy and physics have shown beyond a reasonable doubt that our universe did in fact have a beginning. Prior to that moment there was nothing; during and after that moment there was something: our universe.”

It suggests that billions of years ago the universe began in a tiny, infinitely hot and dense point called a *singularity*.

It is a scientific fact that “nothing produces nothing”.

So where did the singularity point come from?

(Any scientific answers? No.)

This *singularity* supposedly contained not only all the material mass and energy that would become everything we see today, but also “space” itself. According to the theory, the *singularity* rapidly expanded, spreading out the energy and space.

What caused the rapid expansion and when?

(“When” is estimated at 15 billion years ago but where is the scientific data to support that?)

One Big Bang website said, “Where did it (the singularity) come from? We don't know. Why did it appear? We don't know.”

It is estimated that over vast periods of time, the energy from the big bang cooled down as the universe expanded. Some of it turned into matter—hydrogen, helium gas and trace amounts of lithium.

Where is the scientific evidence for that?

These immense gases collapsed to form stars and galaxies of stars. (Scientific evidence? “When” has been estimated at 10 billion years ago but how do they know?)

Some of the stars created the heavier elements in their core and then exploded (which ones, why did they, where is the scientific evidence, and when?)

The explosion distributed these elements into space. Some of the heavier elements supposedly began to stick together and formed the earth and other planets.

Where is the scientific evidence for that and when was it meant to happen? (How do heavier elements “stick together”? Don’t rocks etc break up when they meet? The sun was estimated to be formed 5 billion years ago and the earth 4.5 billion years ago but where is the evidence for that?)

The oceans were then formed. (Scientific evidence? But “when” was estimated at 3.8 billion years ago.)

So the difference between Evolution's Big Bang theory and God's creation, which involves about 6,000 years to date, is seen below.



The Bible's Time Forecast Is different to the Evolutionary Time Forecast

Evolution says:

- “During the next four billion years, ...”
- “... the rate of cooling of the planet's interior,”

The Bible Says about the Lord Jesus returning to the sky:

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 “For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven ... the dead in Christ (believers in Christ as Saviour) shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall ... ever be with the Lord.”

This could happen at any moment and after that the world will exist for about 1,007 more years.

The Lord Jesus coming for believers in Him will be followed by:

2 Thessalonians 2:3 “Let no man deceive you by any means: ... that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, ⁶ shewing himself that he is God.”

The Bible's Forecast of the Earth's Future

- Daniel 9:27 “And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week (speaking of seven years) he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, ...”
- After seven years Zechariah 14, Matthew 25 and Revelation 19 show that the Lord will return to the earth to reign for 1,000 years, Revelation 20:4 “... reigned with Christ a thousand years.”
- Revelation 20:11 “And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.”
- 2Peter 3:10 “But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.”

So God does speak of a big bang but He says that it will be at the end of time when He finishes with the earth and before the final judgment.

If anyone wishes to ask questions then they are welcome. However we have a choice. We either believe what men say, with little scientific evidence to prove it, or we believe God's Word, and the evidence for God.

God not only spoke of this life but says in 1 Timothy 4:8 " ... the life that now is, and of that which is to come" which is eternal life and is received by faith in Christ as Saviour from sin. Evolution cannot offer you an eternal sinless and joyful future, due to your sins being forgiven and you not knowing God's judgment.
